



Veriditas Facilitator Training with Dr. Chi-Shan Lam

Workshop description:

The goal of Veriditas Labyrinth Facilitator Training is to prepare people to introduce others to the labyrinth in an articulate, professional and effective way. The training addresses meditative walking in a variety of settings, with a variety of different populations. It is focused primarily on the Eleven Circuit Medieval Labyrinth but is inclusive of all forms.

Walking the labyrinth is being embraced as a spiritual practice throughout the Western world mostly because of Veriditas trained facilitators. The Veriditas Facilitator Training -- which began in 1997 -- remains the most rigorous and comprehensive training offered.

Educational Objectives:

Upon completion of this session, attendees will be able to enhance knowledge about labyrinth in general and specifically, design the labyrinth events and present the labyrinth to the attendee's community.

Dr. Chi-Shan Lam is a specialist Anaesthesiologist serving in public hospital in Hong Kong. He first connected with the labyrinth walking when he studied the Clinical Pastoral Education in 2009. In the same year, he got the Master of Arts in Christian Studies from the Chinese University of Hong Kong. Currently, he is a candidate of the Professional Doctorate in Practical Theology. His ongoing thesis “labyrinth walking, spirituality and healthcare” is based on his research “A quantitative and qualitative evaluation of labyrinth walking on chronic pain patient” which is kindly supported by the Hong Kong Pain Society research grant (2015).

Dr. Lam is a Veriditas facilitator trainer/faculty who has been offering facilitator training workshop for the local communities since 2021.

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
